## **A1.2 SPANISH**

**19.02.-15.05. 2024 (50 academic hours)**

**Days of the week: Monday and Wednesday**

**Time: 18:30-20:00**

**Group size: 10 (maximum)**

This course is for the experienced beginners in Spanish. The main emphasis of the course is on practical language usage in simple daily communicative situations; hence, the communicative method is used.

At the end of the Spanish A1.2 course the learner can ask and answer simple questions about daily and leisure time days and interact in an elementary way whenever a native speaks slowly and clearly and has the will to cooperate. To sum up, the learner will be able to satisfy immediate needs.

The main topics that will be covered are the following:

- Introducing my home and my neighbourhood; food and recipes; introducing and describing people; making plans and meeting; going to a restaurant or a bar; making a reservation; describing holidays; asking for and giving directions, making suggestions; talking about activities we are doing right now; talking about the weather; going shopping; colours, clothes and size; comparing; parts of the body, sicknesses and at doctor's; what are we going to do in the future.
